Kroos Control topped the round, by a margin

ArtetaVision picked up points again, as they start to climb up the table

Pick points are made up from all the pre-season league teams you picked, and the players you have in your Fantasy Team

If your cup teams stay in their competitions, then they start to score big points as they progress through the rounds and can make a huge difference to your final position.

R34 takes us up to **3781** games played so far, yielding the points won in the Picks competition.

406 Of these have been games that have made up 'The 12' as well, and all the points we have won, or not, in those games

Lard Lovers XI stay top of The Picks but another 42 points has been cut off the lead they have.

The pack is closing in.

And it's the FA Cup in R35 which can see some big points awarded for any team you picked still in the competition, and winning games.
