

## Season 25/26 - Round 30

It's time to be brutally honest with everyone. Collectively, when it comes to this football thing, boy we're shit!!! I thought the Cup Round was bad, but that had at least the excuse of cup upsets causing huge point losses. No excuse this time though, as we have managed to post the worst round ever since I started keeping records of these kind of things (not that long).

Banking in This Round has 2 Guaranteed, 0 Immune and 1 Enhanced CORRECT SCORES. Embarrassingly, out of the 110 Bankers placed, **102 of them were WRONG.. 32 of the 70** finished with negative scores, and we averaged **MINUS 2.14**

29.67 points won the round, with Racing Todabogs picking up the only Enhanced score due to Callum Wilson's late strike. It helped balance out the two wrong bankers.

Kroos Control avoided bankers, and picked up two correct scores to finish second, boosted by Brighton's late goal on Monday Night.

No Trophy Wife also avoided bankers, had Leeds to beat Fulham 1-0. In their 26 points,

and MC11 had only three correct results in their 23 points, BUT, had banked on all three!!!

The POTR was Matz Sels, his clean sheet and 5 saves registered 24 points, and was worth 10 points in the table for the 5 that picked him.

The two Highest backed players, Florian Wirtz and John McGinn, didn't make the top 5, and therefore picked up zero points for the 30 that had picked them.

The Last Player Standing evictions from this round increased to two per round.

Each round, the worst will be eliminated, leaving 6 or 7 to fight it out in the final round of the season for the Last Player Standing Trophy (and £130)

Before the Brighton equaliser, Saved By The Belle were out with Dutch United FC, so they were saved by the Albion, and Empire Of The Son said Sayonara to the competition.

The next six can feel a little fortunate, all had scores that would have eliminated them in the previous rounds

If your cup teams stay in their competitions, then they start to score big points as they progress through the rounds and can make a huge difference to your final position. Players can also score big points, and for those bothered, there is another Transfer Window opened before Round 31 kicks off.

R30 takes us up to 3266 games played so far, yielding the points won in the Picks competition.

**358** Of these have been games that have made up 'The 12' as well, and all the points we have won, or not, in those games

Lard Lovers XI stay top of The Picks.

Bachman & Robin have moved above MullenVoid into second

Apart from the lead the leader has opened up, it remains close behind.
